Petitioner is currently appealing the resulting judgment. 23 January 7, 2014 he filed a motion to stay the present matter during the pendency of the 24 appeal. (ECF No. 21.) 25 The present action has been dismissed, and the case is closed. As the case is not 26 pending, the motion to stay the action is DENIED as moot. Should the Ninth Circuit
