ALROWHANY, Defendants 15 16 17 On June 17, 2014, the Court issued an order to Plaintiff to show cause why sanctions should not 18 be imposed for failing to appear at the scheduling conference and failing to comply with the Court's 19 order to file a joint status report and an amended scheduling report. (Doc. 17) On June 30, 2014, 20 Plaintiff's counsel responded and explained that due to a calendaring error, he failed to appear at the 21 scheduling conference. (Doc. 19 at 2) Counsel indicates he has directed further training of his staff so 22 that this kind of error does not occur again. Id. However, counsel offers no explanation for the failure 23 to file the joint status report or the amended scheduling order.¹ 24 Despite the incompleteness of counsel's explanation, the Court **ORDERS**: 25 1. The order to show cause is **DISCHARGED**. 26 Counsel for all parties are admonished that the Court will tolerate no further delays in 27
