18	Plaintiff, George Garcia, a state priso	ner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed
19	this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on August 30, 2013. On September 4, 2013,	
20	the undersigned dismissed Plaintiff's Complaint for failure to state a claim upon which relief may	
21	be granted and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within 21 days. 28 U.S.C. §	
22	1915A; 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). Plaintiff requested and received an extension of time to file an	
23	amended complaint. To date, Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the	
24	Court's order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets forth any claims upon which	
25	relief may be granted under section 1983.	
26	Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e), the undersigned	
27	HEREBY RECOMMENDS that this action be dismissed, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's

1	failure to state any claims upon which relief may be granted under section 1983. It is further	
2	recommended that dismissal of this action count as a strike under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).	
3	These Findings and Recommendations will be submitted to the United States District	
4	Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within 15	
5	days after being served with these Findings and Recommendations, Plaintiff may file written	
6	objections with the Court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's	
7	Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the	
8	specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d	
9	1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
