**ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND  
RECOMMENDATIONS**

(ECF Nos.16, 18, 57)

14 Gary W. Vanderbusch (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma*  
15 *pauperis* in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed the complaint  
16 commencing this action on September 5, 2013. (ECF No. 1.) The matter was referred to a  
17 United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

18 On December 11, 2017, Magistrate Judge Erica P. Grosjean entered findings and  
19 recommendations recommending that all claims and defendants, except for Plaintiff’s claim  
20 against Defendant Chokatos for deliberate indifference to serious medical needs in violation of  
21 the Eighth Amendment, be dismissed. (ECF No. 57). Plaintiff was provided an opportunity to  
22 file objections to the findings and recommendations within fourteen days. The fourteen-day  
23 period has expired and Plaintiff has not filed objections to the findings and recommendations.

24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this  
25 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file,  
26 the Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper  
27 analysis.

28 Accordingly, THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The findings and recommendations issued by Magistrate Judge Erica P. Grosjean on December 11, 2017 are ADOPTED IN FULL; and
2. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) all claims and defendants, except for Plaintiff's claim against Defendant Chokatos for deliberate indifference to serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth Amendment, are DISMISSED.
