21	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
22	On April 13, 2017, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations,	
23	recommending that plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunctive relief be denied, without	
24	prejudice. (Doc. No. 201.) The parties were granted fourteen days in which to file objections to	
25	the findings and recommendations. (Id.) The fourteen-day time period has passed, and no	
26	objections have been filed.	
27	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636 (b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 304, this	

court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the

1	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis

3	1. The April 13, 2017 findings and recommendations (Doc. No. 201) are adopted in full	
4	and	
5	2. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunctive relief (Doc. No. 192) is denied, without	
6	prejudice.
