18	through six of the first amended petition as untimely. On April 27, 2015, Petitioner opposed the	
19	motion, contending that since the statute of limitations was tolled by Petitioner's October 28,	
20	2013, filing of a state habeas corpus petition in Merced County Superior Court, claims two	
21	through six, as set forth in the petition pending before this Court had been timely filed. On May	
22	21, 2015, Respondent filed the letter of Linda Romero Soles, Court Executive Officer for the	
23	Criminal Division of the Merced County Superior Court, stating that the Court had no record of	
24	Petitioner's filing a state petition for habeas corpus on or about October 28, 2013. Petitioner did	
25	not respond.
