Bussiere, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, 12 13 filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This case was recently assigned to the 14 undersigned for all purposes. (Doc. 111.) While a settlement conference has been conducted 15 (Doc. 107), the parties were to continue negotiations after Plaintiff had an opportunity to review 16 case documents including District Judge Anthony W. Ishii's order of April 4, 2017 (Doc. 94). 17 Thus, the parties shall notify the Court whether they feel further settlement conference would be 18 beneficial. 19 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED, that within twenty-one (21) days of the date of 20 service of this order, the parties shall file statements indicating whether they believe, in good faith, that settlement is likely in this case and whether further settlement conference would be 21 beneficial.
