11 **ORDER REQUIRING PARTIES TO
NOTIFY COURT WHETHER A
SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE WOULD BE
BENEFICIAL**

12 **TWENTY-ONE (21) DAY DEADLINE**

13 Plaintiff, Arthur T. Bussiere, a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis*,
14 filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This case was recently assigned to the
15 undersigned for all purposes. (Doc. 111.) While a settlement conference has been conducted
16 (Doc. 107), the parties were to continue negotiations after Plaintiff had an opportunity to review
17 case documents including District Judge Anthony W. Ishii's order of April 4, 2017 (Doc. 94).
18 Thus, the parties shall notify the Court whether they feel further settlement conference would be
19 beneficial.

20 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED, that within **twenty-one (21) days** of the date of
21 service of this order, the parties shall file statements indicating whether they believe, in good
22 faith, that settlement is likely in this case and whether further settlement conference would be
23 beneficial. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send Plaintiff a copy of Judge Ishii's order of
24 April 4, 2017, (Doc. 94), with service of this order.
