(Doc. 113) 12 TIGGS-BROWN. 13 Defendant. 14 15 Plaintiff, Arthur T. Bussiere, was a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis 16 in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds on Plaintiff's First 17 Amended Complaint on Plaintiff's claim against Defendant Tiggs-Brown for deliberate 18 indifference to Plaintiff's serious medical needs in violation of the Eighth Amendment. 19 Defendant has filed a notice of Plaintiff's death (Doc. 120) and a proof of service pursuant to 20 Rule 4 on Plaintiff's nonparty successors or representatives (Doc. 122). 21 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 25(a)(1) allows ninety days after service of the notice of 22 death for the decedent's non-party successors or representatives to file a motion for substitution. 23 Plaintiff's non-party successors or representatives were served with the notice of Plaintiff's death 24 in this action on December 22, 2017, and may file a motion for substitution anytime within ninety days thereafter. This case is currently set for trial on February 27, 2018, which is before the 25 26 deadline for filing a motion for substitution. (Doc. 113.) As such, the trial and all pretrial 27 deadlines must be vacated.
