



1 Before the Court is Plaintiff's August 26, 2015 request that the money orders be  
2 returned to him. (ECF No. 150.) On March 25, 2016, the Court ordered defense  
3 counsel to advise the Court of the whereabouts of the money orders or funds. (ECF  
4 No. 153.) Defense counsel responded on April 14, 2016, providing evidence that the  
5 money orders had been returned to the United States Marshals Service on September  
6 29, 2015. (ECF No. 154.) The Marshals Service has informed the Court that the money  
7 orders were returned on September 30, 2015 to Esperanza Hernandez, 1589 E. 48th  
8 Place, Los Angeles, CA 90011.

9 Because the money orders have been returned to the person who procured  
10 them for Plaintiff, Plaintiff's request for reimbursement is moot and is therefore  
11 HEREBY DENIED.
