

1 On July 10, 2014, the Court ordered Plaintiff to show cause within fourteen days
2 why the action should not be dismissed with prejudice for failure to obey a court order
3 and failure to prosecute. (ECF No. 17.) Plaintiff did not timely respond to the order.

4 On July 30, the Court issued findings and a recommendation to dismiss the
5 action. (ECF No. 18.)

6 On August 6, 2014, Plaintiff filed his response to the Court's order to show cause.
7 (ECF No.19.) Plaintiff explained that he recently received a brace to alleviate his wrist
8 pain, but that his pain continued to increase with typing and writing, preventing him from
9 complying with all of the Court's orders in his various cases. Plaintiff seeks an additional
10 thirty day extension to file his amended complaint in this action.

11 The Court finds good cause for Plaintiff's failure to timely comply with the Court's
12 order to file an amended complaint. (ECF No. 16.) Accordingly, it is HEREBY

13 ORDERED:

- 14 1. The Court's Findings and Recommendation to Dismiss Action for Failure to
15 Obey Court Order and Failure to Prosecute (ECF No. 18) are VACATED;
- 16 2. The Court's Order to Show Cause (ECF No. 17) is DISCHARGED; and
- 17 3. Plaintiff is granted thirty (30) days from the date of service of this order in
18 which to file an amended complaint.
