Plaintiff did not pay 18 the filing fee in this action and instead filed an application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant 19 to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. However, Plaintiff's application was not adequately completed. Plaintiff's 20 application has redacted the amount in his checking or savings account. Additionally, Plaintiff 21 answered question five as not applicable, but then crossed the answer out indicating that he may 22 own assets. Accordingly, the Court will order Plaintiff to complete and file an Application to 23 Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs (Long Form) – AO 239. If Plaintiff is 24 unwilling to complete and submit the long form application, Plaintiff must pay the filing fee in 25 full. 26 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 27 1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis is DENIED without prejudice; 28 1

3	3. Within twenty (20) days of the date of this order, Plaintiff shall either (1) pay the
