The matter was 20 referred to United States Magistrate Judge Barbara A. McAuliffe pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) On February 18, 2014, the Magistrate Judge issued Findings and and Local Rule 302. 22 Recommendations that the Motion be GRANTED and the matter be remanded to the Calaveras County Superior Court for further proceedings. (Doc. 10). The Findings and Recommendations were served on all parties and contained notice that any objections were to be filed within fifteen (15) days 25

of the date of service. More than fifteen days have passed and no party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a de 4 novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Findings and Recommendations issued February 14, 2014, are adopted in 8 full; 2. Plaintiff's Motion to Remand is GRANTED: 10 3. All pending motions are to be terminated; 11 4. This action is remanded to Calaveras County Superior Court for all further 12 proceedings; 13 5. Plaintiff is awarded \$2,520 in attorneys' fees incurred as a result of improper 14 removal; 15 6. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case; and 16 7. This order terminates this action in its entirety. 17 18 IT IS SO ORDERED. 19 /s/ Lawrence J. O'Neill
