20 This is an immigration case in which Plaintiff Nishan Singh seeks to compel action
21 on his long pending application for naturalization. Both parties have consented to
22 Magistrate Judge jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). (ECF Nos. 7-8.)

23 On January 29, 2014, Defendants filed a motion to remand the action back to the
24 United States Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS"). (ECF No. 9.) On March
25 6, 2014, the Court granted the motion and remanded the action to USCIS. Further, on
26 June 24, 2014, the Court granted Plaintiff's motion for attorney's fees. (ECF No. 26.)
