The Court referred the matter to the 17 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and Local Rules 302 and 304. 18 On August 4, 2015, the Magistrate Judge filed findings and recommendations in which 19 she recommended that the Court deny Petitioner's motion for an order of stay and abeyance to 20 permit exhaustion of unexhausted claims. The findings and recommendations, which were served 21 on all parties the same day, provided that objections could be served within thirty days and replies 22 23 within fourteen days after the filing of any objections. Neither party filed objections. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), having carefully reviewed 25 the entire file de novo and considered Petitioner's objections, the Court finds that the findings and 26 recommendations are supported by the record and proper analysis. 27 28

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	1. The findings and recommendations filed August 4, 2015 (Doc. No. 29) are adopted in full;
3	2. Plaintiff's motion for an order of stay and abeyance (Doc. No. 24) is DENIED; and
4	3. The case is referred to the Magistrate Judge for further proceedings.
