**ORDER EXTENDING DISCOVERY
AND SCHEDULING ORDER TO
DEFENDANTS KING AND PORTER**

Plaintiff is a civil detainee proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action. The action is proceeding on Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint filed on February 4, 2016.

On April 4, 2016, the Court issued a Discovery and Scheduling Order. Since then, certain Defendants initially named have been replaced in their positions, and the current individuals holding those positions have been substituted into this action.

On May 31, 2016, Defendants King and Porter filed an answer. Therefore, the Court EXTENDS the April 4, 2016, Discovery and Scheduling Order to Defendants King and Porter. Deadlines to amend pleadings, conduct discovery, and file dispositive motions as set forth in the initial Discovery and Scheduling Order are EXTENDED to Defendants King and Porter. In addition as to Defendants King and Porter, the deadline to provide initial disclosures is set for thirty
