More than fifteen (15) days have passed and Plaintiff has not complied with the order or otherwise responded to 21 the Court's order. Plaintiff was warned that dismissal would occur if he failed to obey the order. 22 A civil action may not proceed absent the submission of either the filing fee or a completed 23 application to proceed in forma pauperis. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914, 1915; Fed. R. Civ. P. 3, 11(a). Based 24 on Plaintiff's failure to comply with the Court's order, dismissal of this action is appropriate. In re 25 Phenylpropanolamine (PPA) Products Liability Litigation, 460 F.3d 1217, 1226 (9th Cir. 2006); 26 Local Rule 110.
