Nos. 79, 121) 15 Defendants. 16 17 Plaintiff Gregory Ell Shehee is a former civil detainee proceeding pro se and in forma 18 pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action proceeds against 19 Defendants Nguyen and Estate of J. Tur on plaintiff's claim alleging that he received inadequate 20 medical care from defendants while he was a civil detainee, arising from events occurring before 21 plaintiff's surgery in April 2013, in violation of the Fourteenth Amendment. This matter was 22 referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 23 302. 24 On March 5, 2019, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations 25 recommending that defendants' motion for summary judgment be granted. (Doc. No. 121.) The 26 findings and recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice that any 27 objections were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after service. (*Id.* at 22.) No objections

have been filed, and the deadline to do so has expired.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations issued on March 5, 2020 (Doc. No. 121), are adopted in full;
- 2. Defendants' motion for summary judgment (Doc. No. 79), is GRANTED; and
- 3. Judgment shall be entered in favor of defendants and against plaintiff and the Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
