his representation of plaintiff or, at his discretion, proceeding as plaintiff's appointed counsel for purposes of discovery, settlement and/or trial. If counsel does not wish to continue representation of plaintiff after he has carried out his limited purpose, the court will consider appointing new counsel for plaintiff, if deemed appropriate at that time. 3.
