STATUS ON APPEAL 9 FAJARDO, 10 Defendant. 11 Plaintiff Jose Luis Buenrostro, ("Plaintiff"), a federal prisoner proceeding pro se and in 12 forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of 13 Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). On January 30, 2018, the Court dismissed this 14 action for failure to state a claim. (ECF Nos. 64, 65.) On February 15, 2018, Plaintiff filed a 15 16 motion for reconsideration together with a notice of appeal. (ECF Nos. 66, 68.) On March 22, 2018, the Court denied Plaintiff's motion for reconsideration and directed the Clerk of the Court 17 to process Plaintiff's notice of appeal. (ECF No. 67.) 18 On March 29, 2018, the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals referred the matter back to this 19 20 Court for the limited purpose of determining whether in forma pauperis status should continue for the appeal. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3). The Court finds that this appeal is not taken in bad faith and 21 22 is not frivolous.
