Plaintiff has submitted an incomplete declaration: he has failed to provide responses to 13 paragraphs 4, 5, and 6, and provided conflicting and incomplete information in his response to 14 15 paragraph 2. As a result, the Court cannot conclude that Plaintiff satisfies the requirements to 16 proceed in forma pauperis according to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). 17 Accordingly, the Court DENIES Plaintiffs' motion to proceed in forma pauperis.
