

1 On March 1, 2018, the Court issued findings and recommendations to the assigned district
2 judge, recommending that Defendants' motion for summary judgment be denied in part and
3 granted in part, and that Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment be denied. (ECF No. 85).
4 Defendants filed their objections to the findings and recommendations on March 21, 2018, and
5 Plaintiff filed his objections on March 22, 2018. (ECF Nos. 88, 89). The findings and
6 recommendations were adopted in full on March 28, 2018. (ECF No. 91).

7 On February 23, 2018, Defendants filed a motion for summary judgment on the merits.
8 (ECF No. 83). On March 23, 2018, Plaintiff filed his opposition to the motion for summary
9 judgment. (ECF No. 90). On March 30, 2018, Defendants filed their reply. (ECF No. 93).

10 On April 5, 2018, Plaintiff filed the instant motion for an extension of time. (ECF No. 95).
11 Plaintiff requests an extension of time to oppose the motion for summary judgment on the merits,
12 (ECF No. 83), and to object to the findings and recommendations, (ECF No. 85). *Id.* Plaintiff
13 contends that he requires an extension of time because he was placed in "the hole" without access
14 to the law library and is very sick. *Id.*

15 Plaintiff's motion is, however, moot. Plaintiff has filed his respective opposition and
16 objections. (ECF Nos. 89, 90). And, all pending motions are now fully briefed and submitted.
17 *See* Local Rule 230(l). Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion is denied.
