(Doc. 15) 13 ESLICK, et al., 14 Defendants. 15 Plaintiff Jose Augustine Mayorga, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma 16 pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on January 23, 2014. 17 Plaintiff's federal constitutional claims arise out of events in 2012 at Sierra Conservation Center in 18 Jamestown, California. 19 On April 10, 2014, Plaintiff filed a motion seeking an order granting him priority law 20 library status. 21 The discretion to grant or deny inmates priority law library status rests exclusively with 22 prison officials, see Griffin v. Gomez, 741 F.3d 10, 20-1 (9th Cir. 2014), and the pendency of this 23 action does not give the Court jurisdiction over staff at Pleasant Valley State Prison, Summers v. 24 Earth Island Institute, 555 U.S. 488, 493, 129 S.Ct. 1142, 1149 (2009); Lujan v. Defenders of 25 Wildlife, 504 U.S. 555, 559-61, 112 S.Ct. 2130 (1992); Mayfield v. United States, 599 F.3d 964, 26 969 (9th Cir. 2010). 27 28

1	Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion for priority law library status is DENIED.
