ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS AND DENYING
PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

Plaintiff Jason S. Harper is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On July 7, 2014, the Magistrate Judge issued a findings and recommendations recommending that Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunctive relief be denied, with prejudice. (ECF No. 19.) Plaintiff did not respond.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper

1 analysis.

2 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 3 1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed July 7, 2014, are adopted in full and
4 2. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunctive relief (ECF No. 16) is DENIED, with
5 prejudice.
