19	Plaintiff David Torosian filed a complaint on January 29, 2014, along with an
20	application to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915, which was granted.
21	Plaintiff's complaint was screened by the U.S. Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §
22	1915(e)(2) and dismissed with leave to amend. On April 23, 2014, Plaintiff filed a First
23	Amended Complaint which was dismissed on May 8, 2014, with 30-days leave to amend. (Doc.
24	5.)
25 26	Plaintiff failed to file an amended complaint, and on July 9, 2014, the Magistrate Judge
20	issued Findings and Recommendations that Plaintiff's complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
28	Plaintiff was given 28 days to file objections to the Findings and Recommendations. On August

1	14, 2014, Plaintiff filed a Second Amended Complaint. (Doc. 7.) On the same day that
2	Plaintiff's Second Amended Complaint was entered on the docket, the Court adopted the
3	Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations, dismissed Plaintiff's complaint, and closed the case. Plaintiff failed to timely file a Second Amended Complaint or file objections to the
4	the case.
5	Plaintiff failed to timely file a Second Amended Complaint or file objections to the
6	

Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommedations. As such, the Second Amended Complaint filed on August 14, 2014, is STRICKEN as untimely.¹
