Plaintiff filed this action on February 5, 2014. On March 19, 17 2014 and May 12, 2014, Plaintiff filed motions requesting service of process on the defendants. 18 (ECF Nos. 8 & 9.) 19 Because Plaintiff is proceeding in forma pauperis, he is entitled to have process served on his 20 behalf by the United States Marshal. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(d); Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(c)(3). However, as set 21 22 forth in the Court's First Informational Order, the Marshal will be directed to initiate service of 23 process only after Plaintiff's complaint has been screened and found to state cognizable claims for 24 relief. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A; First Informational Order, ¶12, ECF No. 3. Therefore, Plaintiff's 25 motion for service shall be denied as premature. 26 /// 27
