17	On February 19, the Court held an informal telephone conference regarding a discovery dispute		
18	between the parties. At the conference, Defend	ant agreed to amend its response to requests 18 and 21	
19	of the request for production to indicate that it had located no document responsive to the requests.		
20	As to requests 21, 22, 23 and 24, Defendant agreed to produce the documents for an in camera		
21	review. In addition, Defendant will provide the Court a summary of its policies, whether formal or		
22	informal, as to how credit worthiness bears on hiring decisions for all job types including those where		
23	the prospective employee is seeking a job where the applicant will have access to cash and those where		
24	the applicant will not have access to cash. In the event the Court determines there are documents that		
25	are responsive, the Court will initiate a telephone conference for further discussions.		
26	Though the parties were unable to come to informal agreement regarding request 28 and the		
27	deposition of Jamee Pugh, they had resolve the issue related request 27 before the conference.

2	1. No later than February 27, 2015 , Defendant SHALL produce to the Court documents		
3	responsive to requests 21-24 along with a brief summary of Defendant's policies regarding the		
4	creditworthiness of prospective employees. The summary SHALL be provided to Plaintiff's counsel		
5	also. If Defendant wishes, the original documents may be personally delivered by a custodian of the		
6	records who may await their return after the review is completed. In this is Defendant's preferred		
7	course, it SHALL set up an appointment with the Court, by contacting Courtroom Deputy Clerk, Susan		
8	Hall (661-326-6620/SHall@caed.uscourts.gov);		
9	2. Plaintiff is authorized to file a motion to compel as to request 28 and the deposition of		
10	Jamee Pugh. The motion SHALL comply with Local Rule 251(c).
