17	Jeanette Sepeda ("Plaintiff") seeks judicial review of an administrative decision denying her	
18	claim for Social Security benefits. (Doc. 1.) Plaintiff filed a motion to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i>	
19	with her complaint on February 20, 2014. (Doc. 2.)	
20	The Court may authorize the commencement of an action without prepayment of fees "but a	
21	person who submits an affidavit that includes a statement of all assets such person possesses [and]	
22	that the person is unable to pay such fees or give security therefor." 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). The Court	
23	has reviewed the application and the information provided is insufficient to determine whether Plaintiff	
24	satisfies the requirements of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a).	
25	According to her application, Plaintiff l	has not been employed since 1976, and has no cash or
26	savings. (Doc. 2 at 1-2.) Plaintiff asserts her only income includes \$245 per month for General	
27	Assistance and \$198 in food stamps. <i>Id.</i> at 1.	Further, Plaintiff notes she does not have any real

28 estate, stocks, bonds, securities, other financial instruments, an automobile, or other things of value. 1

1	<i>Id.</i> Given this economic condition, it does not appear that Plaintiff is able to support herself on these	
2	funds alone. Consequently, the Court must determine whether Plaintiff is dependent upon another	
3	individual who would be able to pay the filing fee.	
4	Accordingly, Plaintiff is ORDERED to file, within fourteen days of this order, an application	
5	that includes information on how Plaintiff is supporting herself, or whether she is dependent upon	
6	another. Upon receipt of this information, the Court will resume consideration of Plaintiff's motion to	
7	proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> . Plaintiff is warned that failure to comply with this order may result in	
8	denial of her application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> .
