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17	Plaintiff Jacob Michael Renshaw, a prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed	
18	this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on March 4, 2014. On June 5, 2015, the Court	
19	dismissed Plaintiff's amended complaint for failure to state a claim under section 1983 and	
20	ordered Plaintiff to file a second amended complaint within thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A; 28	
21	U.S.C. § 1915(e). More than thirty days have passed and Plaintiff has not complied with or	
22	otherwise responded to the Court's order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets forth	
23	any claims upon which relief may be granted.	
24	Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A and 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e), this action is	
25	HEREBY DISMISSED, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim upon which	
26	relief may be granted under section 1983. This dismissal is subject to the "three-strikes" provision	
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1	set forth in 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g).	Coleman v. Tollefson, U.S,, 125 S.Ct. 1759, 1765
