17 Plaintiff Juan Matias Torres is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action
18 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

19 On March 19, 2015, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations which was
20 served on the parties and which contained notice to the parties that Objections to the Findings and
21 Recommendations were to be filed within thirty days. The thirty day time frame has expired and no
22 objections were filed.

23 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a *de*
24 *novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings and
25 Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed on March 19, 2015, is adopted in full; and
2. Plaintiff's motion for a court order to obtain confidential calls during the discovery phase of litigation is DENIED.
