**STIPULATION AND ORDER  
MODIFYING PROTECTIVE ORDER**

21 The parties, through their attorneys of record, stipulate to modify the Court's protective  
22 order, ECF No. 97, as follows:

23 The audio recording of Defendant's interview (Exhibit 63) contains the first names of the  
24 Defendant and other correctional staff. The Court has found that the first names and other  
25 personal identifying information can be redacted, and should not be released to the Plaintiff.  
26 However, the audio file cannot be redacted. Accordingly, the audio recording of Defendant's  
27 interview shall be released to Plaintiff's counsel, but shall not be played for or otherwise shared

1 with the Plaintiff. However, Plaintiff's counsel may discuss the substance of Defendant's  
2 interview with his client.
