**ORDER DISMISSING ACTION, WITH
PREJUDICE, FOR FAILURE TO STATE
A CLAIM UPON WHICH RELIEF MAY
BE GRANTED UNDER SECTION 1983**
(Docs. 1 and 7)

Plaintiff Gregory Ell Shehee, a civil detainee proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on April 25, 2014. On October 10, 2014, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's complaint for failure to state a claim under section 1983 and ordered Plaintiff to file an amended complaint within thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e). To date, Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the Court's order. As a result, there is no pleading on file which sets forth any claims upon which relief may be granted. Accordingly, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e), this action is **HEREBY DISMISSED**, with prejudice, based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim upon which relief may be granted under section 1983. **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
