12 Felipe Garcia ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action
13 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff filed the Complaint commencing this action on April
14 28, 2014. (Doc. 1.)

15 On September 24, 2014, Plaintiff filed a motion for correction to the court's docket in
16 case 1:13-cv-00599-LJO-SKO. (Doc. 14.) This motion is more properly brought in case 1:13-
17 cv-00599-LJO-SKO. Therefore, the motion shall be denied in this case. If Plaintiff wishes the
18 court to consider his motion, he must file a separate motion in case 1:13-cv-00599-LJO-SKO.¹

19 Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion, filed on September 24, 2014, is DENIED.
