On December 11, 2014, Plaintiff and 19 20 Defendant Carolyn W. Colvin, Acting Commissioner Social Security, stipulated to a voluntary remand of Plaintiff's Social Security appeal for further administrative proceedings. (Doc. 16.) The parties seek 21 remand to have an administrative law judge "further develop the record; further evaluate Plaintiff's 22 mental impairments; further evaluate the medical source opinions of record and Plaintiff's residual 23 24 functional capacity; and obtain additional vocational expert evidence if necessary." (*Id.* at 1-2.) Further, the parties noted the matter was to be remanded under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). 25 26 (*Id.* at 2.) 27 /// 28 ///

Based upon the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The matter is **REMANDED** under four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g); and
- The Clerk of Court is DIRECTED to enter judgment in favor of Plaintiff Dwayne
 Wilson and against Defendant, Carolyn W. Colvin, Acting Commissioner of Social
 Security.
