Plaintiff has not yet filed an amended complaint, though the time for doing so has not yet 21 expired. 22 On June 30, 2014, Plaintiff filed his second request to disqualify the magistrate judge. Other 23 than questioning judge's intelligence, Plaintiff presents no arguments that would alter the Court's 24 order denying his first request. Insofar as faults the Court for omitting any reference to California 25 Code of Civil Procedure section 170.6, Plaintiff is informed that this action is in federal Court and is 26 governed by the *Federal* Rules of Civil Procedure. 27
