16	Plaintiff Kenneth Henry, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed		
17	this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on May 23, 2014. The action was referred to		
18	a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.		
19	On January 6, 2015, the Magistrate Judge screened Plaintiff's complaint and recommended		
20	that (1) the action proceed for monetary damages against Defendants Jolly, Contreras, and Ortega		
21	for use of excessive physical force, in violation of the Eighth Amendment, and (2) Defendant Cate		
22	be dismissed based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim against him. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A.		
23	Plaintiff filed a timely notice of non-objection to the findings and recommendations on January		
24	22, 2015. Local Rule 304(b).		
25	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the Court has conducted a		
26	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings		
27	and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

5		Amendment;
6	3.	Defendant Cate is dismissed based on Plaintiff's failure to state a claim against
7		him; and
8	4.	This matter is referred back to the Magistrate Judge for service of process.
