CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT **CORRECTIONS** 12 CONNIE GIPSON, et al., 13 (ECF No. 5) Defendants. 14 15 Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action brought 16 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. 17 On June 5, 2014, the Court granted Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma 18 pauperis, and ordered the Director of the California Department of Corrections or his 19 designee to collect payments for filing fees for this action from plaintiff's prison trust 20 account in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2), until a total of \$350.00 has been 21 collected. (ECF No. 5.) On July 15, 2015, Plaintiff paid the remaining balance of the 22 applicable filing fee in full. 23 In light of the filing fee having been satisfied, it is HEREBY ORDERED that: 24 1. The order directing payment of the inmate filing fee by the California 25 Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (ECF No. 5) is HEREBY 26 VACATED; 27 2. The Director of the California Department of Corrections is directed to 28

1	cease collecting payments from Plaintiff's prison trust account in relation to
2	this action;
3	3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the
4	Director of the California Department of Corrections, via the court's
5	electronic case filing system (CM/ECF); and
6	4. The Clerk of Court is directed to serve a copy of this order on the Financial
7	Department, 12 U.S. District Court, Eastern District of California, Fresno
8	Division.
