16	December 23, 2016, the parties filed a stipulation for voluntary dismissal of the action, with prejudice,
17	pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). (ECF No. 41.) Pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1),
18	this case has now terminated automatically. <u>See</u> Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1).
19	Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:
20	1. The Clerk shall CLOSE this case in light of the parties stipulated dismissal with prejudice
21	under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii); and
22	2. Any pending motions (including Doc. Nos. 30 and 37) are DENIED.
