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17 Plaintiff Derrick Jesus Oden, Sr., (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in
18 forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff initiated this
19 action on June 9, 2014.

20 On February 13, 2015, the Court dismissed Plaintiff’s first amended complaint with leave
21 to amend within thirty days. 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. Plaintiff was warned that if he failed to file a
22 second amended complaint in compliance with the order, this action would be dismissed for
23 failure to obey a court order and failure to state a claim. More than thirty days have passed, and
24 Plaintiff has not complied with or otherwise responded to the order.

25 The deadline for Plaintiff to file his amended complaint has passed and Plaintiff has not
26 complied with or otherwise responded to the Court’s order. As a result, there is no pleading on
27 file which sets forth any claims upon which relief may be granted.
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
