26 **PROPOSED ORDER**

27 The parties filed a joint stipulation to dismiss this case. (Doc. 50) The stipulation
28 relies upon Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, under which “the plaintiff
relies upon Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, under which “the plaintiff
may dismiss an action without a court order by filing . . . a stipulation of dismissal
signed by all parties who have appeared.” Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).

Because all parties who have appeared in the action signed the stipulation, it
“automatically terminate[d] the action.” Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692
(9th Cir. 1997). Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS:**

1. Clerk of Court is **DIRECTED** to close this action;

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2. The Court retains jurisdiction to enforce the parties’ settlement agreement.
