3	authorize the filing of the stipulation by May 8, 2015, Plaintiff would proceed to ask that the
4	Court enter an order dismissing his Complaint. Moore Decl., ¶ 3. Defendants' counsel has not
5	authorized the filing of the stipulation to date. Moore Decl., ¶ 4.
6	Plaintiff requests this dismissal on the grounds that a settlement agreement was entered
7	into between Plaintiff and Defendants, and under the terms of that agreement, Plaintiff agreed
8	to dismiss his Complaint once Defendants had made the payments required under the
9	agreement. Moore Decl., ¶ 5. Defendants have made the first of such payments, and therefore,
10	Plaintiff seeks to dismiss his Complaint as required.
11	For the reasons set forth above, Plaintiff respectfully requests that the Court dismiss his
12	Complaint filed in this action.
