15	pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Individuals detained pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions	
16	Code § 6600 et seq. are civil detainees and are not prisoners within the meaning of the Prison	
17	Litigation Reform Act. Page v. Torrey, 201 F.3d 1136, 1140 (9th Cir. 2000).	
18	On December 8, 2016, the Court granted Defendants' motion for an order requiring Plaintiff to	
19	post security due to his vexatious status, and Plaintiff was directed to post security in the amount of	
20	\$14, 195.00 within thirty days or the action would be dismissed. (ECF No. 61.) Over thirty days	
21	have passed and Plaintiff has failed to post security. Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that the	
22	instant action is dismissed, and Plaintiff's motion for summary judgment filed on November 14, 2016,	
23	is denied as moot.
