

1 rights cases. Plaintiff may be assured that his complaint will be screened in due course, but he lacks
2 legal entitlement to demand that his case be moved to the front of the line for review. 28 U.S.C. §
3 1915A.

4 Plaintiff requests a copy of the Court's docket sheet for this case. Although Plaintiff does not
5 indicate the need for a copy of the court's docket sheet in this case, in the interest of justice the Court
6 will provide Plaintiff a copy of the docket sheet. However, Plaintiff is advised that the Clerk does not
7 provide free copies of case documents to parties. The Clerk charges \$.50 per page for copies of
8 documents. See 28 U.S.C. § 1914(a). Copies of up to twenty pages may be made by the Clerk's
9 Office at this Court upon written request and prepayment of the copy fees. The fact that the Court has
10 granted leave for Plaintiff to proceed in forma pauperis does not entitle him to free copies of
11 documents of the Court. Under 28 U.S.C. § 2250, the Clerk is not required to furnish copies without
12 cost to an indigent plaintiff except by order of the judge.

13 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 14 1. Plaintiff's first amended complaint will be screened in due course; and
- 15 2. The Clerk of Court is directed to send Plaintiff a copy of the docket sheet for this case.

16 IT IS SO ORDERED.
