17 On May 26, 2015, the parties stipulated for Defendant to have an extension of time file a
18 response to Plaintiff's opening brief. (Doc. 16.) The Scheduling Order allows for "a single thirty (30)
19 day extension" by stipulation of the parties. (Doc. 5-1 at 4.) The parties were informed that any further
20 extensions of time must be requested by written motion, and would not be granted without good cause.
21 (*Id.*) Previously, the parties stipulated for an extension of time for Plaintiff to serve a confidential letter
22 brief. (Doc. 17 at 2.) Therefore, the Court construes the parties' stipulation to be a motion by
23 Defendant for an extension of time.

24 A scheduling order "is not a frivolous piece of paper, idly entered, which can be cavalierly
25 disregarded without peril." *Johnson v. Mammoth Recreations, Inc.*, 975 F.2d 604, 610 (9th Cir. 1992).
26 The deadlines are considered "firm, real and are to be taken seriously by parties and their counsel."
27 *Shore v. Brown*, 74 Fed. R. Serv. 3d (Callaghan) 1260, 2009 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 94828 at *7 (E.D. Cal.
28 Oct. 9, 2009). Here, Defendant's counsel "respectfully requests this additional time because he has a

1 very heavy workload despite due diligence.” (Doc. 16 at 1.) By signing the stipulation, Plaintiff
2 indicates there is no opposition to the request. Therefore, the Court will grant Defendant’s request.
3 However, the parties are cautioned that no further extensions of time will be granted without a showing
4 of exceptional good cause.

5 Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

- 6 1. Defendant’s request for an extension of time is **GRANTED**; and
- 7 2. Defendant **SHALL** file a response to Plaintiff’s opening brief on or before
8 **June 19, 2015.**
