On October 7, 2014, the Court dismissed Plaintiff's complaint 17 with leave to file an amended complaint within thirty days. (ECF No. 11.) On October 17, 18 2014, Plaintiff filed the instant motion for discovery. (ECF No. 12.) 19 20 Plaintiff's motion for discovery is premature and shall be denied without prejudice. At this time, there is no operative complaint on file, no defendants have been ordered served and 21 discovery has not been opened in this matter.
