Plaintiff Quincy Sims, a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, filed this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 on July 21, 2014. On June 15, 2015, Plaintiff filed a notice of appeal and a motion seeking leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal.

Plaintiff was proceeding in forma pauperis in this court and therefore, his motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal is **HEREBY ORDERED DENIED** as moot. Fed. R. App. P. 24(a)(3).
