(Doc. 8) 9 10 On July 23, 2014, Defendants Kraft Foods Group, Inc., and Manuel Perez removed this labor 11 discrimination case from Fresno County Superior Court to this Court, alleging federal jurisdiction. 12 On August 21, 2014, Plaintiff Bi Sophamixay moved to amend her complaint, stating that Plaintiff 13 erred in referring to her protected medical leave as being governed by the federal Family and 14 Medical Leave Act of 1993 (29 U.S.C. § 2601 et seq.) ("FMLA") when the leave was in fact 15 governed by state law, the California Family Rights Act (California Government Code § 12940). 16 Plaintiff also moved for remand following the proposed amendment. On September 23, 2014, 17 Defendants filed a statement of non-opposition. 18 The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's motion and finds the proposed amendment to be consistent 19 with the context of the original complaint and appropriate to correct the error. Accordingly, the 20 Court hereby GRANTS Plaintiff's motion to amend. Since the complaint no longer alleges a federal 21 question following the amendment, The Court REMANDS this matter to the Fresno County 22 (California) Superior Court and DIRECTS the Clerk of Court to CLOSE the case. 23 24 IT IS SO ORDERED.
