20	On November 16, 2016, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and	
21	recommendations recommending that plaintiff's July 8, 2016 motion for leave to file a	
22	supplemental complaint (Doc. No. 43), be denied. (Doc. No. 50.) Plaintiff was granted fourteen	
23	days to file any objections to those findings and recommendations. <i>Id.</i> Despite seeking and	
24	receiving an extension of time in which to do so, plaintiff has not submitted any objections, and	
25	the time to do so has expired. (See Doc. No. 58.)	
26	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, the	
27	court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the
