23	summary of judgment; or (ii) a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who	
24	have appeared.	
25	Fed. R. Civ. P. 41 (a)(1)(A). "The Plaintiff may dismiss some or all of the defendants, or	
26	some or all of his claims, through a Rule 41 (a)(1) notice, " and the dismissal	
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"automatically terminates the action as to the defendants who are subjects of the notice." Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111F. 3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Accordingly IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is to close this case. IT IS SO ORDERED. 1st Michael J.
