18 On May 21, 2015, the Court issued a Findings and Recommendation recommending that	
19 Petitioner's motion to stay the petition be denied and that the petition be dismissed without	
20 prejudice. (ECF No. 24). The Findings and Recommendation informed Petitioner that he may	
move to withdraw the unexhausted claims, file objections to the Findings and Recommendation,	
or file a motion for a stay pursuant to <u>Kelly v. Small</u> , 315 F.3d 1063, 1070-71 (9th Cir. 2002),	
23 within thirty days of the service of the Findings and Recommendation. Upon a review of the	
24 docket, it appears that Petitioner was not served with the Findings and Recommendation or the	
25 Court's February 6, 2015 Order Granting Petitioner's Motion for Extension of Time to File a	
26 Traverse. The Court notes that although Petitioner did not receive the Court's February 6, 2015	
order, he filed a motion for stay and abeyance on February 27, 2015.	
Therefore, the Court will direct the Clerk of Court to serve copies of the May 21, 2015

## Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- The Clerk of Court is directed to serve a copy of the May 21, 2015 Findings and Recommendation (ECF No. 24) and the February 6, 2015 Order Granting Petitioner's Motion for Extension of Time to File a Traverse (ECF No. 22) on Petitioner;
  - Petitioner is granted thirty (30) days from the date of service of the Findings and Recommendation to move to withdraw the unexhausted claims, file objections to the Findings and Recommendation, or file a motion for a stay pursuant to <u>Kelly v. Small</u>, 315 F.3d 1063, 1070-71 (9th Cir. 2002); and
  - Any reply to the objections or a motion for a stay pursuant to <u>Kelly</u> shall be served and filed within **fourteen** (14) days after service of the objections or the motion for a stay pursuant to <u>Kelly</u>.
